Medical Forms

School Meals

Payment for School Meals and Activities

We operate ParentPay for parents/carers to pay for meals and activities in school. Your new user ID and password can only be issued after your child is registered with us on their first day of school. This process will take a few days when your child joins us but they can order and receive school meals during the time your ParentPay account is being set up.

Free School Meals

The Universal Entitlement to Free School Meals for your child stops when they move into Year 3. This means that if your child is eligible to continue to receive free school meals, you need to apply. Please apply for Free School Meals online as soon as possible (https://www.warwickshire.gov.uk/education-learning/apply-free-school-meals).

If your child is not registered with this department by the beginning of the Autumn Term 2025, unfortunately they will not receive a free school meal when they join Telford Junior School in September.

If you think your child may be eligible for free school meals but you are intending to provide packed lunches, it would be very beneficial to the school if you could still apply. The school receives funding based on the number of registered children eligible for free meals and we rely on this funding in order to cover all the costs associated with running the school.
