Consent Form for Local Area School Visits

During Your Child's Time at Telford Junior School

Throughout the year, the school organises a number of routine visits and journeys away from the school site, as part of the children's learning experiences. Such visits take place during the school day and tend to be local to the school area. The school always ensures that there is an appropriate ratio of adults to children on such occasions and visits are carefully planned and risk assessed by staff. All visits and journeys away from the school site are approved by the Education Visits Coordinator.

The purpose of this consent form is to enable parents/carers of children at the school to give their permission for their children to participate in frequent, local, curriculum-focused visits and journeys away from the school, during the school day.

Please sign and date the form below, if you are happy for your child to take part in local visits and journeys.

Please note the following important information before signing this form:

- 1. The visits and journeys covered by this consent form take place during the school day.
- 2. They include sporting events and swimming lessons.
- 3. They are usually on foot, but can also involve coach or minibus transportation (e.g. swimming lessons and sporting events).
- 4. They are in the local Warwickshire and Coventry area.
- 5. Further written parent/carer consent will not be requested from you for these local visits. This form applies throughout your child's time at Telford Junior School and covers all local area school visits.
- 6. The school will send you information about each visit or activity before it takes place.
- 7. You can, if you wish, inform the school that you do not want your child to take part in any particular school visit or activity.
- 8. Medical consent will not be requested specifically for these activities, but will be taken from the school's general consent form, signed separately.
- 9. Any visit that: involves adventurous activities; is residential; involves visiting a site with specific environmental hazards (e.g. rivers or the coast), or travelling a distance will require specific informed consent from parents/carers.
