## Year 4 Residential to the Pioneer Centre, Cleobury Mortimer, Kidderminster Wednesday 25<sup>th</sup> March - Friday 27<sup>th</sup> March 2026

Dear Parent/Carer

We are very excited to be able to offer your child the opportunity to take part in a residential visit to the Pioneer Centre, Kidderminster. This will be for a 3 day and 2 night stay from Wednesday 25th March to Friday 27th March 2026. If you do not wish your child to attend this visit then an alternative curriculum will be offered in school.

We believe that there are many benefits to be gained from engaging in residential, outdoor learning experiences. These include personal and social development, where independence, team work, confidence and self-esteem can be raised and strengthened through fun and challenging group activities. Many of these benefits can be transferred back into the classroom and beyond where they can have real and lasting impact.

Working in teams, your child will participate in a number of adventurous activities. We will send you a more detailed itinerary nearer the time. They will sleep in dormitories with school staff close by. The total cost of the visit will be £210 which includes transport, meals, activities and accommodation.

In order to secure your child's place on the residential visit, a **non-refundable** deposit of £70 is required, along with confirmation of consent to attend the trip. This must be paid, and consent provided, on ParentPay by **Friday 24**<sup>th</sup> **October 2025**. It is important to emphasise that the deposit is non-refundable and should you decide to cancel this trip at any time, as with all holiday cancellations, you will be subject to incremental charges linked to the point at which you cancel.

A second instalment of £70 will be required by Friday 5<sup>th</sup> December 2025, with the final payment of £70 due by Friday 9<sup>th</sup> January 2026.

We would also like to stress that the children's behaviour in school will greatly influence whether or not they are invited to go on the visit. We need to put the children's safety first and be able to trust that all children will follow the instructions given by an adult and be responsible individuals. We hope that parents and carers will support our stance on this and reiterate this message at home.
