RSPB Big Schools' Birdwatch – Year 5 Leading the Way

Next week, our Year 5 pupils will be taking part in the **RSPB Big Schools' Birdwatch**, led by Mr Fox, Year 5 teacher and Science Lead. The children will be spending time observing and identifying birds around our school grounds, helping to contribute to a national wildlife survey run by the RSPB.

The Birdwatch is a fantastic opportunity for pupils to develop their observation skills, learn more about local wildlife and understand how scientists collect real data to help protect nature. We are hoping that other year groups will also be inspired to join in and take part where possible.

Mr Fox has introduced the RSPB Birdwatch during his assembly this week, explaining what it involves and how everyone can get involved, both at school and at home.

Families may also like to explore the **Merlin Bird Identifier app**, which is free and fun to use. The app can help identify birds by answering a few simple questions or even by **listening to birdsong**, making it a great way to spark children's interest in nature. 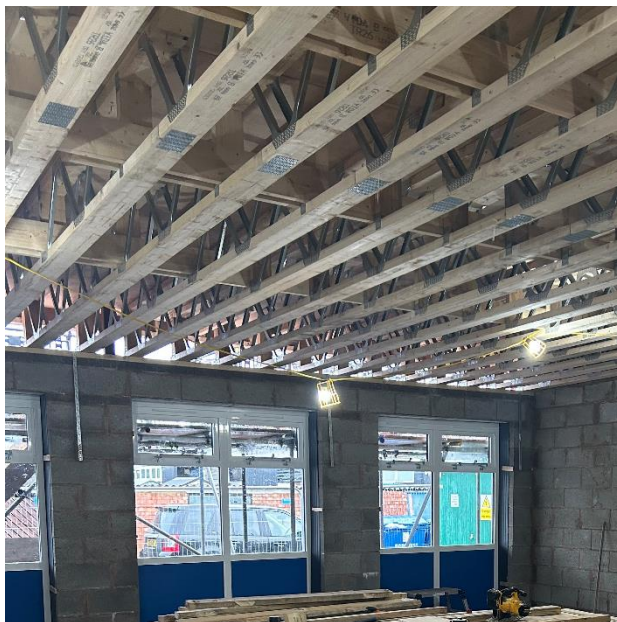
