Message from Warwickshire Police

Warwickshire Police wish to bring to your attention a number of concerns that have been raised regarding parking and driving conduct in the vicinity of the school, during morning drop-off and afternoon pick-up periods.

We have received reports of vehicles being parked in a manner that causes obstruction, including stopping on hatched markings, obstructing the highway and limiting visibility for pedestrians and other road users. Such behaviour presents a significant risk to the safety of children, staff and members of the wider community. In response to these concerns, officers will continue to conduct patrols and any offences that are identified will be dealt with appropriately, which may include the issuing of traffic offence reports.

We respectfully request that all parents and carers ensure their parking and driving practices comply with local regulations and are carried out with due consideration for the safety of others. Your cooperation is essential in helping us maintain a safe environment around the school.

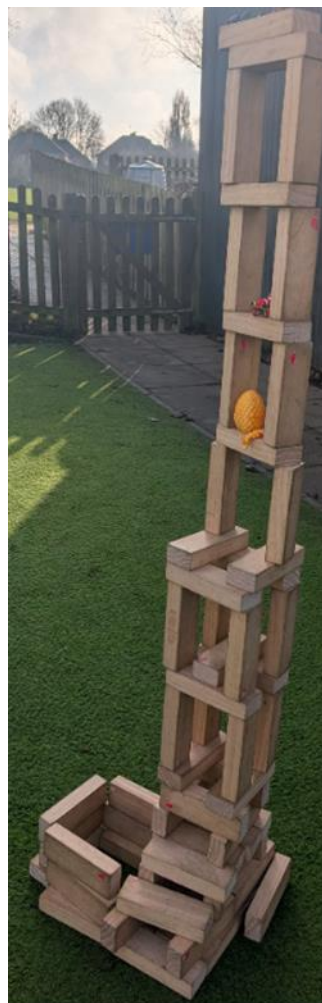
