#### **Exciting Site Developments Underway!**

We are delighted to share that building work is now taking place on our school site, funded through the Department for Education's Condition Improvement Fund (CIF). As an academy, we were able to apply for this funding following our conversion, and we are thrilled to see the project taking shape.

The works have seen the removal of our old temporary classrooms during the Summer, to be replaced with a brand-new permanent modular building. The new facilities will provide two classrooms, toilet facilities and an office space – all designed to benefit the whole school community. They will be used for breakfast and after-school provision, intervention groups, learning activities and as a base for external professionals and services supporting our pupils.

We are also hoping to enhance the project further by creating an all-weather outdoor learning space, providing even more opportunities for our pupils to thrive.

This development represents a significant investment in the future of our school and we look forward to welcoming pupils, staff and the wider community into these much-needed new spaces very soon.



# DON'T FORGET BOOK BINGO!

YOUR AUTUMN READING CHALLENGE



Later this term, we will be launching a new programme called **Accelerated Reader**, which will replace the reading diaries that children usually bring home with online quizzes linked to their reading books. We will update you more about how the scheme works once we have familiarised ourselves with it and have the software up and running.

In the meantime, we will be starting the half term with a slight change to our expectations for reading at home. We would like all of the children to try and read at least **one book from the school reading scheme each week** (the teaching staff will keep a record of the books that each child reads at home) and we are also going to launch **Book Bingo**, as a fun reading challenge for the children to try to complete during the Autumn Term. All children completing the challenge will receive 5 Dojo points and a certificate from their class teacher. Your child will bring home a Book Bingo sheet. Happy Reading!
