Our Week in School

It has been an exciting week in school, filled with learning, discovery and welcoming new faces.

Our Year 3 pupils have begun their fascinating journey back in time as they explore the Stone Age. This week, Y3 Beech class enjoyed a fantastic Stone Age workshop, led by a member of the Warwick Museum Service. The children had the opportunity to handle real artefacts, including arrowheads, flints and other tools made from stone. They explored how these tools changed and became more sophisticated over time and thought about what life might have been like thousands of years ago - from how people found their food through farming, hunting and gathering, to the clothes they wore and the shelters they built.











Meanwhile, Year 5 had a very special visitor. Maya's uncle, who works for the European Space Agency, came in to talk about his work designing spacecraft that will travel to Mars. The children were full of brilliant questions and were inspired to think about the possibilities of future space exploration.

We were also delighted to welcome prospective parents/carers to the school this week. Families of pre-school children looking to join the Infant School next September, as well as parents/carers of current Year 1 and Year 2 children, were given a tour of the school. Guided by our staff, visitors enjoyed seeing the learning environment and finding out what life is like as pupils move into the Junior School.
